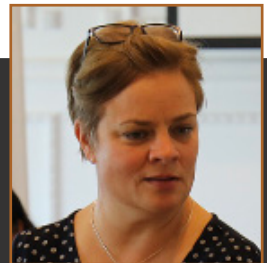


Leadership & Management in a Christian organisation is a marathon, not a sprint ... and there are hurdles along the way.
